#### **Excellent Customer Service at Ballina Visitor Centre**

The Ballina Visitor Information Centre conducted half yearly customer satisfaction surveys in November 2011. Over 300 surveys were completed and visitors were interviewed by an independant Southern Cross University PHD student. Here are some the results you may find interesting...

- 96% of visitors use Visitor Information Centre when travelling
- 32% of visitors use the internet to plan their holiday
- 99% of visitors were either very satisfied or satisfied with the quality of service at the Ballina Visitor Information Centre
- 37% of visitors were very satisfied, 58% satisfied with their visit to Ballina Coast and Hinterland
- 63% were overnight visitors, 37% were day visitors
- 64% were Australian, 22% from Europe, 11% from United Kingdom, 2% from New Zealand

Surveys are complete every six months, in one off-peak and one peak season. The results are reported to Council as one of the service delivery targets for the Tourism section.
