The Rainbow Region Dragon Boat Club will be holding its second annual dragon boat regatta at Shaw's Bay on 30 & 31 August 2014, and we are seeking sponsorship for this event.

The regatta will draw approximately 700 participants and spectators to Ballina over the two days, from the North Coast of NSW and South East Queensland. At this present time we have 6 clubs and 8 community sports team registered, but this will change as we get closer to the regatta. This could be a valuable opportunity to promote your Ballina Shire Council to locals and visitors alike, as well as cementing your name in the community through association with our event.

A \$500 sponsorship would enable Ballina Shire Council, to have a feature race named in its honour (and depicted on the trophies for that race). A little bit of background for you:

*Our club was originally formed in 2005 as Rainbow Dragons Abreast, a club for breast cancer survivors and their supporters. Due to the huge popularity of the sport (dragon boating is the fastest growing water sport in Australia, with 60 clubs in NSW), we expanded to become a sports club, the Rainbow Region Dragon Boat Club, in 2009. Rainbow Dragons Abreast still exists as a group within the larger club, which now caters for men and women of all ages and abilities. Our club attracts members from Ballina, Byron, Lismore and surrounds, out to Kyogle and Mullumbimby.*

*Our nearest clubs are the Clarence Coast Dragon Boat Club (which operates out of Yamba and Lawrence) and Mount Warning Dragon Boat Club (which is affiliated with the Queensland Dragon Boat Federation), (recently photographed in the Echo Newspaper) making us the most northern club under the Dragon Boats NSW (DBNSW) umbrella. We travel all over NSW to attend regattas, as well as interstate and even overseas. This year we entered a team in the AusChamps National Dragon Boat Championships (held in Queensland) for the first time. Several of our members are part of a team travelling to Sarasota, Florida in October (just recently in the media for getting local sponsorship) and others recently competed in New Zealand.*

*This, our second regatta, is officially sanctioned by DBNSW and supported by the other North Coast clubs, as well as generating interest from clubs as far away as Sydney and South East Queensland. Due to the success of last year's Rainbow Region Regatta and the opportunity this event generates in fund raising for the maintenance of our dragon boats, the costs of managing our club, and the public interest in the sport of paddling a dragon boat, we seek your support in our endeavour to achieve a successful event.*

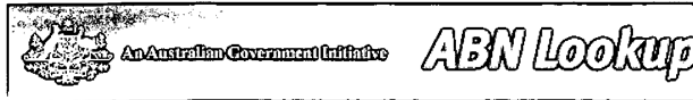
