This policy aims to regulate the grazing of stock on road reserves.

BACKGROUND

Ballina Shire Council is the Roads Authority for the purpose of managing public road reserves within the Shire, (Roads Act 1993). The grazing of stock on public road reserves within Ballina Shire is a matter for the Roads Authority and is in accordance with the Local Land Services Act (2013) and Regulation (2014).

~~The North Coast Livestock Health and Rest Authority will not issue stock permits for the purpose of grazing. The North Coast Livestock Health and Rest Authority will issue stock permits for the purposes of moving stock only. This is in accordance with Rural Lands Protection Act 1998 and the Rural Lands Protection Amendment Act 2008.~~
