The land is presently zoned under Ballina Shire Council LEP 2012 as RE1 "Public Recreation". The land is approximately 1 Hectare in size.

A Draft Concept Plan has been prepared which shows proposed embellishments to the land. The plan aims to build upon previous consultation to incorporate both passive and active recreational uses into a safe, attractive and family friendly community space.

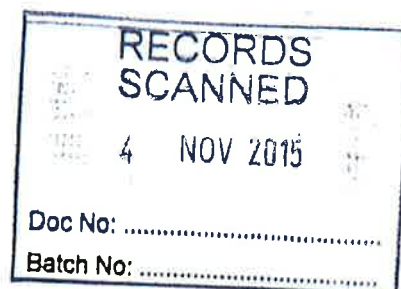

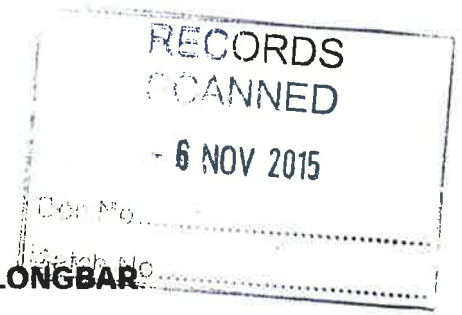
