Truckstop Sk8 would like to submit an Expression of Interest to manage and coordinate a skateboarding event at Missingham Bridge Skate Park in 2017 and 2018.

Using our industry contacts and previous experience at holding such events we hope to attract some of Australia's premier skateboarders to the longest running skateboard competition in Australia (Fair Go) which will be our proposed event. Plus running in junction with the Ballina Prawn Festival for a third year will continue to add another draw card to attract more competitors, spectators and coverage than before. We have already reached out to the new organisers of the prawn festival and they are happy to team up once again.

Our event will be a nationally rated and sanctioned 3 Star event by the Australian Skateboarding Federation (ASF). The ranking points gained at regional contests such as ours assist riders to advance to the National Championships and then on to the Continental Championships which is the qualifying event for skateboarding in the Olympics 2020. Having local events sanctioned and rated are a critical stepping stone to those chasing their Olympic dream.

### **History of Organising Similar Events**

- We have organised many local events from scratch which include arranging sponsorship and prizes, advertising, social media and liaising with community groups and businesses.
- In the last year this included events at Nimbin, Ballina, Suffolk Park, Bangalow, Brunswick Heads and recently at the Love Lennox Festival at Lennox Head.
- For the last two years we have successfully run our premiere event "Fair Go" in conjunction with the Ballina Prawn Festival which has attracted more competitors and spectators than ever before.

#### **Evidence of Public Liability Insurance**

Benefits to holding the skateboard event as part of the festival include, access to market stalls, food vendors, entertainment, traffic management, restrooms and first aid support.

Whilst we will run the skateboard competition autonomously on the day we work closely with the festival organisers both before, during and after to ensure both events run smoothly.

#### **Cost to Participate**

We have always had free entry in the past but may consider charging a fee to assist with costs depending on an arrangement with the Ballina Prawn Festival organisers regarding competitor's entry to the festival. We will review this once further negotiations have taken place.

## Sponsorship

We estimate generating up to \$10,000 in contra prizes and \$5,000 in cash sponsorship as this is what we have done the past two years. This ensures we have a nationally rated 3 Star event with competition points being added to the national ranking system. We have great existing relationships with all our distributors, including brand names such as Vans, Skullcandy, DC Shoes, Globe, Dickies Clothing and Santa Cruz to name a few.

We also have good local business relationships throughout the area and we know how difficult gaining sponsorship can be but we believe our local experience, connections through business and the skateboard industry will help us achieve our goals.
