### KINGSFORD SMITH RESERVE MASTER PLANNING STAKEHOLDER MEETING NOTES

Venue: Meeting Room 1 Kentwell Centre, Ballina Saturday 5 June 2021 (multiple sessions 8:45am - 2:45 pm)

Project Team Attendance: Sheryn Da-Re (BSC until 12:30), Tara McGready (BSC 12:30 - close), Nicholas Stevenson (Urbis), Hamish Stinson (Urbis)

Community Group Attendance: Ballina Seagulls Senior Rugby League Club, Tintenbar East Cricket Club, Ballina Netball Club, Truckstop Sk8, Ballina Environment Society, Ballina Farmers Market, Ballina RSL Club Marine Modelers, Ballina Hockey Club.

The Richmond River Sailing and Rowing Club and Ballina Seagulls Junior Rugby League responded and booked a time to attend but did not attend on the day. Oztag were invited but have opted to not participate because they advised that they no longer use Kingsford Smith Reserve and plan to move to an alternative venue in the future.

The following groups were also invited to attend:

- Jali Local Aboriginal Land Council (letter sent)
- NSW Crown Lands (letter sent)
- Park run (email sent to website contact address)
- Ballina Chamber of Commerce (email sent, telephoned and message left)

Meeting Purpose: To liaise with stakeholders to determine how they use the space, their needs and aspirations for the future.

### **SESSION 1: BALLINA SEAGULLS RUGBY LEAGUE CLUB**

- The club objectives include:
  - Supporting kids and the community
  - Supporting other sporting groups
  - Providing facilities to support women in sport
  - Support other non-sports related access and activities
- The facility is centrally located to their NRL district and so is the preferred destination for club games (regional NRL hub)
- The grass on the main field is great and a state of the art playing surface
- The club requires a minimum of 4 change rooms and shower facilities to comply with standards
- The club wants to be compliant with NRL guidelines so that they can get bigger games which bring more people
- The club relies heavily on volunteers so facilities that make it easier for volunteers are desirable
- The club house building is in disrepair:
  - Built in the early 1970's by volunteers and has been added onto in an adhoc manner
  - Low ceiling height which is non-compliant
  - Major sewer issues. The sewer needs to be pumped out every few weeks or it floods the
  - They would like a weights training room within the same building and ground level
  - The ideal layout would consist of home change rooms and visitor change rooms at either end of the building to allow privacy for game strategizing, a central gym, and a canteen

and BBQ area overlooking the fields so volunteers can see game. The upgrade should include a medical room, referee observation area and a meeting room.

- Opposition team grandstands are needed
- Visitation grand finals approx. 7000 8000 people, home games 1000 2000 people. They have had about 15,000 people attend for a major NRL match in the past. Weekly training attracts about 300 people just for rugby plus other sports and school groups.
- There is an alcohol free zone on the southern side for people with children
- The eastern bar functions with all home games and is well used because it is warmer and protected from wind
- The club cited the Yamba Club House and meeting rooms and Piggabeen /Rugby Club (Tweed) as examples of good facilities.
- The junior fields need better lighting and access to toilet facilities without conflicts with vehicles
- The rugby fields also support a variety of other activities such as Carols by Candle Light, Food and Wine Festival, car show etc.

#### **SESSION 2: CRICKET CLUB**

- · This is the club's home field
- They would like a small club house facility. They are happy to share this facility if needed with
  other sports. At the moment they have no shelter from sun or wet weather. We discussed a
  shared club house between junior rugby and cricket and they agreed that this could work.
- The ashes of a local cricketer are turned into the turf pitch
- . The turf pitch is the best on the North Coast
- · The club uses both fields with the junior field being shared with junior rugby
- · The club use the training nets regularly
- Players park on Owen Street and have to manually cart their equipment to the training nets or fields because their activities coincide with netball and it is unsafe to use the internal driveway when both activities are occurring.
- The Owen Street frontage and western sides of the fields get boggy in wet weather and improved drainage is required. It is also boggy between the fields.
- Visitation 100 people on cricket game days and more on carnival or state wide event days.
- · Cricket storage shed could have a slab at the side with an awning to provide shade and shelter.
- There are issues with vandalism of their facilities and often find syringes near the water
- · Sight screens are a low priority but a desired feature to enable higher profile games.
- · Field size is generous and adequate.

The Ballina Sailing and Rowing Club were booked into this session but did not attend.

#### SESSION 3: BALLINA NETBALL CLUB, TRUCK STOP SK8, BALLINA ENVIRONMENT SOCIETY

#### BALLINA NETBALL CLUB

- The club would like to meet the minimum requirements of Netball NSW in all aspects of the facility (surfaces, court locations and sizes, seating, change, a shower etc)
- Existing courts don't comply with the standards
- . The club would like tiered seating with shelter cover, a permanent canteen and storage
- · The club provides all-access activities and support inclusivity
- · Netball runs all year around
- Visitation Approximately 500 participants each Saturday with Tuesday night training and Mondays night social and mixed training and events. The club has 800 – 900 members.
- The runoff space between the courts is inadequate and non-compliant
- The club holds a Schools Cup and Fast 5 tournament which brings participants by bus
- · A club house located on the Owen Street frontage is preferred.

#### TRUCK STOP SK8 - SKATE (MISSINGHAM PARK)

- . The skate group would like to see smart lighting to enable use of the park until 9/10pm
- The skate park is extremely popular and well used by a variety of people, ages and abilities. It is
  a dated design and requires a street course to meet demand. Street riding is the most popular
  form of skating at present. It also supports other users such as roller skaters, inline skaters and
  scooter riders.
- The group would like to see improved seating which overlooks the skate area and more shade.
- A bike pump track would complement the facility
- The existing competitions have approximately 1500 entrants (plus spectators) and are undertaken over 2 days

### BALLINA ENVIRONMENT SOCIETY

- The Environment Society highlighted the importance of trees generally, and in particular large trees, to the space and the importance of improved lighting and safety with provision of tree canopy
- . The group see the site as a key wildlife area
- · They support the use of locally endemic plant species
- Design should consider the impact of lighting on wildlife with reference to National Light Pollution Guidelines for Wildlife Including Marine Turtles, Seabirds and Migratory Shorebirds
- · They would like to see some playground equipment returned to Commemoration Park
- The group see an opportunity for a large fig tree central to Commemoration Park to provide shade, amenity, habitat and play
- The group highlighted opportunities for water sensitive urban design stormwater management solutions rather than piped solutions
- . The group highlighted the drainage issues on the southern side of the netball courts
- The group identified an opportunity for open space areas to also support people to "work" in the
  park (e.g. sit at a table with a lap top in the open air and work)

#### SESSION 4: FARMERS MARKET AND BALLINA RSL MARINE MODELLERS

#### BALLINA FARMERS MARKET (COMMEMORATION PARK)

- . The Farmers Market currently hosts 30 stalls with a DA being lodged soon for approx. 60 stalls
- As a comparison Byron farmers markets have 80 stalls.
- There are drainage problems on the site in periods of rainfall turns into a pool and takes a long time to dry out. Cornelia provided Nick with a photo of the grounds after prolonged rains.
- There is inadequate provision of power to support the activity. Power heads / electricity supply bollards were suggested.
- · There is inadequate opportunity for signage to advertise the markets.
- Traffic is an issue Bentinck Street is a fast road.
- The bump in bump out process works well there
- Parking and fast drivers along Bentinck are a problem
  - People park on the other side of the street to Commemoration Park in an adhoc manner which causes congestion and safety issues. Formalised parking in this area could be beneficial
  - The idea of installing variable speed/message signs when the market is on was suggested
- The representative thought that the current location was a really good location for the markets, even if the markets expanded.

#### BALLINA RSL MARINE MODELLERS

- The club would like vehicle access to the edge of the lake for boat launching.
- The club have a container on site and it is functioning well for storage mower, dinghy, bbq, tables, gazebos and other equipment are stored there.
- · They have 10 members that use the boats there
- They meet there every 2nd and 4th Sunday of the month.
- The club would like a gated access where they have the key.
- There is a wet area along the edge of Boomerang Park where the grass can get boggy. The Kingsford Smith Reserve area used to be a swamp before it was filled for the sports fields. The water body there was created for drainage when the land was filled.

### SESSION 5: BALLINA SEAGULLS JUNIOR RUGBY LEAGUE AND BALLINA HOCKEY CLUB

### BALLINA HOCKEY CLUB

- The club would like some more picnic tables and shade and are looking for grants. They really
  want some shade over a spot at the northern end of the field.
- Parking is an issue.
- The Club house is 10 years old but in good condition.
- . The hockey field will need replacing at some point in the future
- Other groups use the canteen and toilets.
- Other groups hire the room for meetings or other uses such as Meals on Wheels, Learn to Drive business etc.
- Ideally the club would love to get another field in the area but realise that this is probably not a bigger picture priority.

The Ballina Seagulls Junior Rugby League Club were booked into this session but did not attend.

#### Dear Shervn Da-Re and Nicholas Stevenson

As part of BES formal process, this is a summary of the points presented in regards to the Kingsford Smith Reserve upgrade process.


BES believes that urban green spaces are associated with the sustainability of cities due to the wide range of ecosystem services they provide, such as wildlife refuge, carbon capture, reduction of air pollution, biodiversity maintenance, aquifer recharging, and climate regulation. The appropriation of public spaces can lead to a greater degree of social cohesion through the promotion of attachment, residential satisfaction, as well as the increase of social contact. Green areas play a fundamental role in the formation of a support network and the social cohesion of a community. Activities, interventions and upgrades that promote interactions between different actors and can promote social cohesion in a community, which is related to human well-being (Peters et al., 2010; Vargas-Chanes & Merino-Sanz, 2012) by facilitating socialization of different groups and improvement in the local economy (Li, Saphores, & Gillespie, 2015). Currently they have been used as a strategy to tackle climate change for not only as a carbon sinking but also reducing temperatures, mental health as well as water cycle and shaded areas, which is related to the height of the trees.

One of the most important variables correlated to well-being is the degree of naturalness, because green areas are capable of providing greater psychological restoration (Carrus et al., 2013; Hipp, Gulwadi, Alves, & Sequeira, 2015).

To sum up BES considers the integration of the Sports area and nature fundamental for achieving targets related to climate change and social well-being. BES also considers of extreme importance that Council leads the way showing the importance of environmental services provided by green areas. In that particular case we need to evaluate the hydrologic systems as the area not only contain an important urban lake but also it is geographically positioned as a river bank which means Riparian forests ensuring water quality.

In this way the reserve can be used as a platform for education putting into use Nature Play areas, targeting children and youth for nature education being a critical step when influencing the next generation of leaders to take care of their environment.

 Urban areas as a climate change strategy - carbon sinking, reducing temperatures, water cycle and shade. We presented this graph to exemplify the need for natural shading:

- We called attention to the fact that Council should be leading by example when dealing with Riparian areas ensuring that a forested buffer is protecting waterways all along it - river and the smaller lake
- We highlighted the importance of urban parks as an education platform and psychological restoration- Integrating social with the environment (cohesion) in the community supporting network- more nature like design
- The use of native plants, nature trails and pathways, nature sounds- using the most recent data to point to the correlation between the height of trees, naturalness and well-being.
- We call attention to Ballina's position as a wildlife corridor and the lack of urban parks in the CBD. The use of the area as a connection with nature - evaluating the use bird nest houses for local species
- 6. We also mentioned the importance of people feeling safe in regards to lighting.
- 7. Lightning standards according to wildlife standard
- Last not least We also mentioned the potential as an area for work out of the office environment.

#### Good Afternoon

As discussed yesterday, the Ballina Oztag Association has ran its competition at Seagulls Rugby League field and Kingsford Smith North for the past 20 years.

Unfortunately, although the ground is owned by Ballina Council ( Crown Land controlled by a Council I think); recently the Ballina Rugby League Club has forbidden the Oztag Competition to play on the Seagulls Field. The current lighting (Oztag plays Monday's 6pm-8pm) at Kingsford Smith North is inadequate and no ammenities available so Ballina Oztag currently (the last 5 weeks) plays at Saunders Park Ballina S3 and S4 (Ballina Soccer Club has forbidden the use of S1 and S2 and Clubhouse) with the only administration area the public seats adjacent to Kerr Street.

The Ballina Oztag Association has applied for booking the vacant Epic grounds at Lennox Head in the future however no news as yet.

Ballina Oztag would love to return to the Kingsford Smith Fields at some stage in the future, but requires adequate lighting and amenities please. Ballina Oztag requires maximum 6 fields (one field is half a football field so 6 Oztag fields are 3 football fields currently plenty of room at Kingsford Smith playing fields).

On average Ballina Oztag has 16-20 teams on average 12 players per team. Ballina Oztag is hoping to start a Junior Oztag Competition in the future. Ballina Oztag is an incorporated sporting organisation, with public liability linked to the Australian Oztag Association.

I hope this helps moving forward and we look forward to working together in the future.





# Q1 Please tick your age group:





# Q2 Tick the option that best represents the way you attend the parks:





# Q3 What is your connection to Ballina? (please tick all that apply)





# Q4 I currently visit one or more of these parks (Kingsford Smith Park, Commemoration Park and Missingham Park) for: (please tick all that apply)







# Q6 I use Commemoration Park










Q8 Kingsford Smith Park - Please prioritise the things that you think should be included within the master plan for the future of Kingsford Smith Park.












#### Q3 What is your connection to Ballina? (please tick all that apply)




