
An enquiry was made about the old mileage marker that was located in Main Street. The meeting was advised that it was in storage and would be replaced in Main Street.

RE: LINE MARKING AT ROUS

I have lived at 369 Rous Road Rous Mill for 28 years. The improvements that have been done to the road are much appreciated as is the recent adjustment to the intersection with Dalwood Road.

Line marking has been carried out in relation to that intersection and double lines have been marked from approximately 100 metres in an easterly direction from Dalwood Road. That line does not proceed to include the first small hill in the road and I simply request that the Council consider extending the marking for another 100 metres.

If it is within your budget to do so I would suggest that the next hill approximately 1km from Dalwood Road should also be subject of line marking. This site has been the scene of a number of accidents over the years and in December 2002 two people died as a result of a head on collision on the eastern side of that hill.

It has been my observation that some vehicles travel at high speed along this roadway and the drivers do not pay due regard to the obvious dangers of approaching such hills without the required caution.

I have canvassed a number of local residents and they agree with my suggestion. Please consider this request as I feel that the effort and expense would considerably improve the safety of all road users.
