Dear Minister

Thank you for your representations of 16 May 2012 on behalf of Ballina Shire Council concerning the commercial harvesting of pipis.

The NSW Government is aware that there has been a decline in the abundance of pipis in NSW in recent years and recognises the role that pipis play in the broader environment and the importance of the resource to many NSW coastal communities.

I wish to assure you that both myself and the NSW Department of Primary Industries (DPI) are committed to the sustainable management of pipis into the future. That is why the management arrangements for commercial pipi fishing have been bolstered through the introduction of an increased minimum legal size limit and commercial daily and possession limits.

I am advised that recent surveys facilitated by DPI have indicated a recovery in pipi numbers on many NSW beaches. While the recovery appears strong on many beaches, there are still concerns for Stockton and South Ballina beaches. For those beaches, large areas will remain closed to commercial harvesting while monitoring takes place.

Additionally, DPI has initiated research aimed at investigating the abundance and size structure of pipi populations on NSW beaches. DPI will continue to analyse all available information on pipis and work with key stakeholders to refine management controls for pipi harvesting across all relevant fisheries.
