The Ballina Community Men's Shed thanks Council for its generous support in agreeing to lease to the Men's Shed 44 Fishery Creek Road, West Ballina. As directed, we prepared a DA (2012/452) which subsequently has been approved, for the Men's Shed to operate from that site, to build a 40 x 20 shed and to modify the existing house for Men's Shed use.

The cost of the proposed development is great and our resources are limited. We therefore request Council to consider refunding or waiving costs associated with the lodging of the DA, the accompanying mandatory construction certification costs, charges for the critical stage inspections of the proposed works, Developer Contributions and other charges council would normally charge us. We have paid the fee associated with the DA when we lodged, and have been quoted the other costs (listed overleaf) as the development proceeds.

Our reasons for the request to waive these fees are :

1. The proposed development will bring considerable improvements and add value to the Council owned property and so Council will considerably benefit from it as the owner of the land.

An additional 40x20m shed workshop ; 3 Phase power connected to the site ; stormwater drainage improvements to the property ; improved parking and roadways

2. The Ballina Community Men's Shed brings considerable community benefit To the growing membership themselves and their families Considerable benefit to many other community health groups through the various contributions of Men's Shed projects

3. Considerable additional site works and infrastructure are required for that particular low lying property to comply with building requirements in addition to normal construction costs

Fill ; retaining walls ; special stormwater requirements ; making 3 Phase power available to that site.

We would ask that you could bring our request to the appropriate body within Council. Thank you



1. Mission Statement

The Ballina Community Men's Shed Relocation & Expansion Project is a campaign to raise capital funds so as to build a workshop centre/creative meeting place primarily for men in the Ballina Shire and surrounding districts.

Social isolation and a lack of active meeting places for men who enjoy sharing, learning and enjoying diverse hobbles, is an issue for many towns throughout Australia. Exploring new interests and enabling men to display and/or discover their skills set is what the Men's Shed seeks to address. The positive health, social and community benefits are becoming widely recognised by health professionals and are what contributes to the astounding success and growth of the Men's Shed movement in Australia. The Ballina Community Men's Shed has been a member of the Australia Men's Shed association (No 377) for three years and the number of men's sheds has almost doubled in that time.

The men's shed is a non-commercial and a non-profit organisation and so provides a relaxed and social workplace environment.

Our priorities: Safety first. Relationships second. Projects third.

We love to achieve worthwhile projects we can rightly be proud of while working without the stress and pressure of commercial expectations.

It is costly to provide a safe workshop. This document invites you to know our journey, our vision for the future and to consider partnering with us.



2. Progress

The Ballina Men's Shed has been located at Southern Cross K-12 School, Chickiba Drive East Ballina during most of its 3 years and has well and truly outgrown this current workshop. Until now space, timetabling, and an inability to cater for more than one activity 'woodwork' have limited us. We have only been able to safely cope with those men who have managed to find us. We would love to cater for the many more enquires we have received and the broad range of interests expressed by both current members and those inquiring. These include metalwork, basic mechanics, gardening, computers, electronics, art, cooking, model engineering and other social activities like cards. The skill set of members may vary over time so the best shed designs cater for flexibility.

With a pressing need to cater to more men with a greater diversity of interests a vision to create a much larger, lasting structure, specific to our needs has been planned by Ballina Men's Shed Committee.

The project was given a tremendous start when the Ballina Shire Council agreed to lease to Ballina Men's Shed, 44 Fishery Creek Road West Ballina. This property has an existing 2 Bedroom dwelling on lands measuring 4000m2. Development consent has been received for the erection of an additional 40x20m shed on the front portion of the property. The plans allow for the partitioning of this shed to provide rooms that cater to the specific interests of current members and will allow for expansion and diversity well into the future.

The location is less than 5 minutes walk from River Street and is closer to the Ballina CBD than the majority of West Ballina.



3. Product / Service

Ballina Community Men's Shed is the only Men's Shed in Ballina. When fully developed it will offer diverse activities and hobby experiences for men who attend. Meeting times will expand from the present two mornings per week with a safety maximum of 18 men, to a new facility that can cater for up to 50 men at anyone time for 6 days a week.

Having a central location for our various activities will assist with men being able to access the facility more easily. An on site office will facilitate the smooth running of the men's shed.

Issues for men in Australia

In Australia men represent 78% of all suicides, die in greater numbers than women from almost all non-sex-specific health problems. They have higher mortality rates with a 5-year lower life expectancy rate and are less likely to seek medical help until later stages in the illness

Issues for men in Ballina

Of the male population 44% are aged 50 and over. Over 500 have disabilities in the 20-59 age group. The unemployment rate for males remains around 7%.

How the issues above will be addressed by the Ballina Men's Shed

The men's shed provides major preventative and restorative health outcomes targeting all men over 15 who are not in full-time employment.

The Men's Shed provides social inclusion and fellowship for many otherwise isolated men. The Relocation and Expansion of Ballina Men's Shed will enable us to more efficiently tackle these serious male health and social concerns. By engaging men, encouraging them in constructive endeavours, building camaraderie and providing regular information and speakers on health issues relevant to men we will be delivering substantial social and health outcomes for the people of Ballina Shire.

The Ballina Men's Shed is open for all men including those who are retired, unemployed, those with disabilities (often with helpers), men suffering depression or social disconnection, youth and school students. Many of these are or have been represented by members of the present men's shed. We have received many referrals from medical practitioners, Centrelink, employment agencies, Ballina Shire Council and other community organisations.



4. Project Sequence

A. Site preparation

- Tree removal
- Surveyor pegging
- Scraping grass / topsoil from 40 x 20 m2 shed slab site
- · Scraping grass and topsoil from car park area and small new road area
- Obtaining, spreading and compacting clean fill for the slab site
- Obtaining, gravel and spread for all weather car parks and road
- Building a retaining wall for the required elevation for the fill.

B. Shed erection

- Preparation for concrete slab pre-plumbing, tie downs, reinforcement
- Pour the concrete slab and prepare surface
- Shed kit delivery & Shed erection

C. Services

- Plumbing for the shed down pipes & water supply
- 22,000 litre tank
- Storm water spreader at south east block corner
- Sewer to toilets
- Electrical lighting, power
- 3 Phase connection

D. Fit-out

- Dividing rooms of the skillion section of the shed
- Building the loft over the northern section and rooms underneath
- Fit out meeting room / kitchen
- Tiling bathroom
- Stairs to the loft
- Storage racks
- Benches
- Cupboards
- Install dust extractors

E. Exterior

- Landscaping
- Fence & security
- Signage
- Rear Garden







5. Costs and Funding

Projected funds needed to complete the project are approximately \$275,000.

Ballina Shire Council has already provided us with an excellent site and we are seeking further assistance through the waiving of development and building charges normally associated with development for profit.

Grants and requests for funding from both the State and Federal Governments have been submitted, but these have yet to be determined. Approaches will be made to various charitable foundations, businesses, service clubs, churches, community groups and individuals to assist with the needed funds.

Current fundraising efforts

The Men's Shed has also undertaken various fundraising ventures. These include – regular Bunnings Sausage Sizzles, a very successful Monster Garage Sale and a contract to make 50 Indian Myrna Bird Traps for Ballina Council. We aim to follow these events with more monster sales and a major fundraising dinner.

Gifts in Kind

We are seeking the assistance of services or building products in kind from the business community. See section 4 for schedule of works and capital that you may be able to assist with.

We are also counting on the many men's shed members and their friends to help with some aspects of labour at planned working bee days during the project.

We seek your support for this tremendous community project in any way that you think you can help. Together we can do it.



6. Tax deductibility


