5. Items to be Referred to Council

5.1 Request Speed Zone Review - Marom Creek Road

Introduction

A resident has written to Council with a request to reduce the speed zone for Marom Creek Road. A copy of the letter is attached for the information of the committee.

Information

Marom Creek Road is a rural road providing connection to Wardell Road with Rous Mill Road. Marom Creek Road currently has a speed limit of 100km/h.

From data for the whole of Marom Creek Road there are four recorded accidents since 2005. All of these accidents were the result of a loss of vehicle control on certain bends.

Traffic count data is currently being collected in case the Committee requests the RMS to conduct a speed zone review.

Council has not completed any analysis of the density of access locations onto the road, or other factors relevant to a speed zone review.

It would be useful to complete a speed zone review, however Council is mindful of the resources available to the RMS and that this is a rural road with relatively low levels of reported incidents.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That, based on feedback from the RMS regarding resources, the Committee determine whether or not to request the RMS to complete a speed zone review for Marom Creek Road from Wardell Road to Rous Mill Road.

5.2 Special Event - Jim's Group Movember Mowathon

Introduction

An application has been received from Jim's Group requesting approval for an event, the Movember Mowathon Fundraising Walk, to pass through the Ballina Shire.

Information

Jim's Group is a business franchise organisation. Their proposal is for a fundraising walk which starts in Hobart and ends in Cairns. The walkers propose to passing through Ballina Shire on Tuesday 26 November 2013. The fundraising is to support mental health issues like depression.

The walk proposes to be conducted by one walker with a mower with a support vehicle in front and one behind.

The proposal is to follow Highway 1 all the way to Cairns except on freeway locations. The event organizers have been liaising with Councils, RMS regional offices and NSW Police along the route.

The proposed route begins on River Drive with the set down of the walker at approximately 9:30am on Tuesday 26 November 2013. The walker will then walk along River Drive and cross the Richmond River at the Burns Point Ferry. The walker will then walk along Burns Point Ferry Road to River Street and from River Street to East Ballina. From East Ballina they shall walk through Lennox Head and continue along The Coast Road to Byron Bay. This is a moving event with no road closures required.

A copy of the itinerary and route map is attached for the information of the Committee.

The event organiser has contacted Council for our specific requirements in relation to the event passing through the Shire. As the selected route appears the most suitable and given the consultation by the organiser with the NSW Police and RMS regional offices, no special conditions are considered necessary for the conduct of this walk in the Ballina Shire.

Having regard to the above information, it is recommended that the Committee provide its approval for this event as proposed.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Committee approve the application from Jim's Group to conduct a Movember Mowathon Fundraising Walk on 26 November 2013, subject to the event being conducted in accordance with the conditions of approval from the NSW Police and RMS.


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Leg & Ferry Crossing

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River Drive to Burns Point Ferry Rd - Google Maps

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
Burns Point Ferry Rd to River St - Google Maps

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
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


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
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Pine Ave to The Coast Rd - Google Maps

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
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5.3 Request Gazettal Update of 4.6m high Routes in the Shire

Introduction

Following the implementation of the Ballina and Alstonville Bypasses, RMS have written to Council seeking to update the gazette routes for 4.6m high vehicle within Ballina Shire.

The effect of the bypasses was to change a number of names for local roads creating an inconsistency between the new names and the ones in current gazettals. Furthermore some of the roads have segment and other changes in response to the highway construction.

The purpose of this report is to initiate the process to address this issue.

Information

The RMS has provide a schedule of proposed changes to deal with this issue. A copy of this information is attached for the information of the committee. The schedule has two parts, the first being the deletion of roads and the second being the addition of new roads to the approved schedule.

The Council assessment concurs with the RMS proposal. Therefore the recommendation to this report is to endorse the submission as presented.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That in relation to the request from the RMS to amend the 4.6 Metre Route approvals in Ballina Shire following the construction of the Alstonville and Ballina Bypasses, the Committee endorse the schedule of changes set out in the information attached to this report.

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5.4 Special Event - The Inaugural Prawn Festival

Introduction

The Ballina Chamber of Commerce is proposing to host, with the support of Ballina Shire Council a Prawn Festival. The event is proposed to be conducted from 10:00am to 9:00pm on Saturday 16 November 2013 at the Ballina Amphitheatre with parking at Kingsford Smith reserve.

This report considers the required approvals for this event.

Information

This event has two traffic control plans that will be in operation during the event. The first plan deals with parking and pedestrian management. The second is for the fireworks display.

A traffic control plan for parking and pedestrian management has been prepared and is attached for the information of the Committee.

Under this plan there it is proposed for parking to be provided in the reserve with a traffic controller managing pedestrian access across Bentinck Street. From there the pedestrians shall be follow the pedestrian network to the event site.

There is a fireworks display is sited on Missingham Bridge. The request to close the bridge to pedestrian and vehicular traffic from 7:45pm to 8:15pm. During the closure one lane will remain trafficable in the event of an emergency. The closure will be supported by manned traffic control. It is also noted that an alternate route via Prospect Bridge is available for vehicle traffic. A copy of the traffic control plan is attached for the information of the Committee.

The event organiser is proposing to promote the event using local media, businesses, community notices and to notify the nearby properties via a community notification leaflet in a six week marketing campaign. The organiser would prefer to avoid the costs of using VMS plant.

This area has been used for events successfully in the past and the traffic control plans are considered to be satisfactory. Therefore the recommendation to this report is for the Committee to provide its approval to the request.





6. Items Referred to General Manager's Delegate

6.1 Request Stop Sign - Moon Street and Bangalow Road Intersection

Introduction

A resident has written to Council seeking intersection improvements to the Moon Street and Bangalow Road intersection. The request is to change the existing Give Way sign to a Stop sign.

Information

The intersection of Moon Street and Bangalow Road is an acute intersection operating under Give Way control. A layout of the intersection is attached for the information of the Committee. The resident writing to Council is concerned that drivers are failing to sufficiently yield prior to entering into the Bangalow Road traffic stream.

In 2009 the intersection was widened in Moon Street to provide a second lane.

There have been seven reported accidents since 2001 with a trend for rear end accidents.

An inspection of sight lines reveals a sight line of less than 30m to the right for vehicles entering Bangalow Road from Moon Street. This satisfies the requirements for a Stop sign.

Having regard to the above information, it is recommended that the proposal to change from a give way sign to a stop sign be approved.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Committee approve the replacement of the Give Way control with a Stop Control at the intersection of Moon Street and Bangalow Road.

6.2 Request Road Closure - Grant Street

Introduction

Ballina High School has written to Council seeking permission to close Grant Street, from the Grant Street RSL entrance south to the river on 12 November 2013. This date is the school formal for year 12 and the road closure is proposed to improve the safety and congestion in the area resulting from vehicles dropping off students attending the function.

Information

The application proposes to operate the closure on 12 November 2013 from 12:00pm to 6:00pm. The road closure will involve a traffic controller managing vehicle entry into the Grant Street drop off area and directing traffic into and out of the RSL car park. A copy of the proposed traffic control plan has been included as an attachment.

As this is a car park area and does not effect through traffic, and having regard to the safety improvements that the proposal provides, the recommendation to this report is to approve the plan.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Committee approve for closure of Grant Street, for the purpose of the Ballina High School Formal, from the RSL entrance south towards the river on 12 November 2013, subject to the closure being conducted in accordance with the submitted traffic control plan.

The Year 12 formal is booked for Tuesday 12th November 2013 at the Ballina RSL Club with students arriving from 4.30pm.

In past years the student arrival when dressed in formal clothes has been a significant part of the evening. The students hire cars, motorbikes, carriages and other modes of transport. The students are dropped off out the front of the club and the scene of many onlookers, parents, photographers and students borders on chaotic.

The RSL club would like to address the access issues in the afternoon by having the drop off point on the other side of the road to the club entrance. Changing the drop off point would:

- allow onlookers better views of the students and the cars
- improve club patrons access to the entrance of the club
- prevent the roundabout on River St from being blocked
- · increase safety for all people involved

Ballina High School requests the closure of the river end of Grant St on 12th November 2013. The street would be closed for all cars but formal arrivals from the RSL exit south to the river. This would involve the loss of only 16 car park spaces for approximately 6 hours. We believe the road should be closed from 12 noon to 6pm.



6.3 Request Parking Controls - Regatta Avenue

Introduction

An area of Crown land at the corner of Regatta Avenue and Martin Street has historically been used for car parking. The land owner, in response to concerns about damage to the land has installed bollards preventing parking on the land.

This action has prompted a review of the parking controls adjacent to this parcel of land.

Information

The parking on the Crown land was 90 degree parking. Feedback from residents is that when vehicles are parked on both sides the area becomes hazardous as there is not enough pavement width to cater for 2 travel lanes and 2 parking lanes.

Council officers have attended the site and measured the pavement width. The pavement varies in width from 12.7m at the intersection to 9.4m at the boat shed. On the opposite side of the road is a Telstra driveway and the Police vehicle holding yard driveway. There is space for one vehicle to park on this side of the road.

It is proposed to limit parking on the northern side of Regatta Avenue and to formalise parallel parking on the southern side of Regatta Avenue. A layout has been included for the information of the Committee.

RECOMMENDATIONS

 That the Committee approve the installation of parallel parking signage on the southern side of Regatta Avenue for a distance of 30m from Martin Street and No Parking signage on the northern side of Regatta Avenue for a distance of 40m.

8.1 RMS Speed Zone Review - Newrybar Village - Return Advice

Introduction

In reply to a request from the Local Traffic Committee Council has received a response from RMS regarding the speed limit around Newrybar Village.

Information

Council, following consultation with the Local Traffic Committee, referred a request to the RMS for the speed zone at Newrybar Village to be reduced.

In response to this request RMS have completed a speed zone review and have advised Council of the following:

- 1. That the existing 60km/h speed limit on Old Pacific Highway be reduced to 50km/h.
- 2. That the existing 60km/h speed limit on Brooklet Road be reduced to 50km/h from the Old Pacific Highway to 720m west of the Old Pacific Highway.
- 3. That the existing duplicated 100km/h derestricted speed limit R4-2 signs on Brooklet Road be removed and replaced with 'End Speed Limit' 50km/h R4-12 with supplementary 'Reduce Speed to Conditions' G9-318-1 signs.
- 4. Brooklet Road joins Fernleigh Road so it is also recommended that the existing duplicated 100km/h derestricted speed limit R4-2 signs on Fernleigh Road at Tintenbar be removed and replaced with 'End Speed Limit' 80km/h R4-12 with 'Reduce Speed to Conditions' G9-318-1 signs.

Speed Zone Review - Local village roads, Newrybar

Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) have completed a speed zone review of local village roads, Newrybar.

The outcomes of this review are as follows:

- 1. that the existing 60km/h speed limit on Old Pacific Highway be reduced to 50km/h
- that the existing 60km/h speed limit on Brooklet Road be reduced to 50km/h from Old Pacific Highway to 720m west of Old Pacific Highway.
- That the existing duplicated 100km/h derestricted speed limit R4-2 signs on Brooklet Road be removed and replaced with 'End Speed Limit' 50km/h R4-12 with supplementary 'Reduce Speed To Conditions' G9-318-1 signs.
- 4. Brooklet Road joins Fernleigh Road so it is also recommended that the existing duplicated 100km/h derestricted speed limit R4-2 signs on Fernleigh Road at Tintenbar be removed and replaced with 'End Speed Limit' 80km/h R4-12 with 'Reduce Speed To Conditions' G9-318-1 signs.

Enclosed is a copy of the Speed Zone Authorisation for the new speed limits. RMS requests council to notify RMS of the installation date when it is available.

RMS recommends that a warning sign T1-270 is installed on both approaches to the site advising motorists of the permanent speed zone change when the speed limit signs are installed and remain for one week after the installation date.
