





Dear Minister

Thank you for your email of 20 September 2013 on behalf of Mr Stephen O'Keefe about the Building Better Regional Cities programme. I apologise for the lengthy delay in responding.

As you would be aware, the programme was set up by the previous government to invest in local infrastructure projects that support an increase in the number of homes for sale and rent that are affordable for working families on ordinary incomes, in communities experiencing positive jobs and population growth.

The Ballina Heights Drive project was awarded \$5 million under the programme to construct Ballina Heights Drive and associated infrastructure, which provides immediate access to a village centre in Ballina Heights Estate. This in turn is designed to facilitate the development of residential lots, medium density housing, a town centre and community facilities. As part of the funding agreement with the Australian Government, Ballina Shire Council will grant a rebate for 120 residential lots which directly benefit from the infrastructure funded to eligible purchasers with low to moderate household income.

I note that Ballina Shire Council has nominated the Ballina Heights Estate as the subdivision where the rebates will be available to eligible purchasers in this funding agreement. Should the council wish to include other residential subdivisions in their agreement, they should contact the Department of Social Services for this request to be formally considered. Please note the Building Better Regional Cities programme guidelines support new housing developments within eligible regional cities – therefore, the scope is limited to the proposed subdivisions that were not under development prior to the granting of the programme's funding.
