Council's treatment plants run 365 days a year and treat 10.9 million litres of wastewater each day. The free tour will give community members the chance to see Ballina's state-of-the-art facility in action.

Please wear enclosed shoes, hat and bring an umbrella if it looks like rain. As this is a working site attendees need to be 12-years or older. The tour also requires attendees to climb stairs, please contact Council for more information about accessibility.

Ballina Shire Council will be completing night works to repair the road pavement on River Street, between Tweed Street and Henry Philip Avenue, across the nights of **Wednesday 23 October and Thursday 24 October**. Works will be completed from 7pm to 5am by council's contractor, Asphalt Crew RPQ. One lane of traffic will be closed and traffic control will be in place to direct vehicles around the worksite.

Alstonville Temporary Water Outage

Water will be temporarily unavailable from **10pm Thursday 24 October to 5am Friday 25 October 2019** to some properties in Alstonville. Properties located south of Main Street and Ballina Road will be impacted and have been notified via mail. During this time no water will be available via internal or external water outlets.

Council makes every effort to minimise water disruptions to our community. However, this temporary disruption is essential and will allow our Water and Wastewater Section to complete essential routine maintenance and upgrade our water network assets.

Here's some things to remember that will assist during this outage:

- During any water disruption it's important to leave taps off as the water may return at any time.
- When water returns it may be discoloured. This is due to sediment. Please run the tap until the water runs clear.
- Your water may appear milky. This is caused by small air bubbles. Don't be alarmed it is not harmful, and will settle in a short period.
