Morning Eoin,

"Install and Operate Amusement Device or Inflated Device on Private Land"

Following our conversation on Friday morning regarding the fees applied to the above title, I now list the concerns of the Alstonville Agricultural Society Incorporated to the implementation

- a) The Society conducts two major events each year which it will dramatically effect – The Annual Show and New Years Eve for The Children
- b) In both of these events it would be impossible to complete the paper work, until the day before in the case of the show or even on the night of New Years. We appreciate the safety concerns being taken by Council, however cannot see it practical, owing to when the devices are able to be set up
- c) The charges of \$112.00 per ride certainly would make it very difficult for any organization to operate without losses in today's environment
- d) The question Society members are asking is what value are we receiving for this amount paid?
- e) New Years Eve will be lost if this applies, appreciating the Councils donation which has been provided. The real issue is our Society members give up time on a night, where they could be enjoying themselves to see the children have the opportunity to enjoy time as a family. Will they still want to do this?
- f) In the past we have paid for engineers to inspect these rides and I imagine this cost will now be on top of the \$112.00 plus we are paying for food inspections of all food sites. This can range from \$1100 to \$1500.00.
- g) It appears that following discussions at the Agricultural Society Council Meetings in Sydney that Ballina Shire is the only Council requiring these details and subsequent fees.

The Society understand their needs to be charges, but charging for each ride will stop a lot of events The disappointing part to the Society, we were verbally informed of these charges prior to last year's New Year's Eve and when asked where is the form, we have not printed it yet. Following on from this we have asked about the issue three times with no replies back from Council Our Society would appreciate the opportunity to sit down with the members of our riding and discuss this important issue to the Societies future programming
