SERVICE SUMMARY

Once again, the summer holiday period brought some warm, sunny days to the Ballina Shire Beaches, with humidity high and temperatures ranging from 17°C – 32°C. The enticing weather and favourable surf conditions brought about some large beach crowds for the Ballina Shire, keeping the lifeguards constantly on their toes. The beach attendance records saw an increase from this time last year, reporting at 157,508 beach goers across the Ballina Shire beaches with Lennox Head maintaining the highest record (62,793).

Lennox Head, Flat Rock and Lighthouse Beach experienced unstable surf conditions caused by the consistent northerly winds. As a result, the usual patrol areas had to be relocated on a daily basis, away from the dangerous current and rips caused by the wind pattern. Sharpes Beach lifeguards were also kept extremely busy in the last two weeks of the patrol season as they tried to manage surfers and swimmers wanting to use the same sandbank. Due to gutters and rips in other parts of the beach, most beach users were inclined to use the same water area (directly in front of the Lifeguard tower), therefore, creating some difficulty to separate surf craft users and swimmers. Despite these problematic conditions, lifeguards did an extremely good job managing to diffuse any conflict between the two different water users and prevented any incidents from occurring. Overall, lifeguards were required to undertake 21 rescues, most of which were at Lennox Head (9), Lighthouse Beach (5) and Shelly Beach (5).

Throughout the busy period of January, various safety and educational measures were undertaken to continue to keep the Ballina Shire beaches and surroundings safe to enjoy. Tourniquet training sessions were conducted amongst most lifeguards as NSW Surf Life Saving Clubs are slowly adding them to their First Aid kits. Hill Song Church held a camp at Lennox Sport and Recreation Centre, requiring 8 lifeguards to work as event safety officers over the 6 day period. Lifeguards of the event were supervising over 500 church members whilst they swam in Lake Ainsworth, the Pool and at the Beach; a commendable effort.



INCIDENTS

- On the 12th of December 2018, lifeguards at Lennox Head contacted the State Operations Centre reporting a fire 300 to 400 metres north of Lennox patrolled area. The State Operations Centre advised that Fire Control were already aware and were sending three cars. Due to the southerly wind there was no threat to property.
- On the 2nd of January 2019, a member of the public reported to the lifeguards at Lennox Head of a male taking photos of the informant's son. When approached by the lifeguards, the man ran away and drove off in his white van. The lifeguard on duty reported the incident to the Police and the State Operations Centre.
- On the 3rd of January 2019, two children aged 8 and 6 years old approached the lifeguard on duty at Lennox Head as they could not find their father. The father was last seen at their accommodation, Blue Paradise, approximately 30 minutes prior to the report. The State Operations Centre was called to notify the Police, however, shortly after, the father was found and the children were returned.
- On the 11th of January 2019, the State Operations Centre was contacted by a lifeguard at Sharpes Beach requesting assistance from an Ambulance for a 20 year old female who was having an allergic reaction to a blue bottle sting. Lifeguards attended to the patient whilst waiting for the Ambulance to arrive. Once they had arrived, the paramedics treated the patient and she was released.
- On the 18th of January 2019, assistance was requested from Marine Rescue for lifeguards as a boat was overturned in Richmond River mouth with two people on board. The persons of interest appeared to be attempting to right their vessel, however, shortly after they were seen drifting away from the vessel. Multiple assets were tasked to attend the scene, including Surf Rescue 40, Westpac helicopter via NSW ambulance and Lighthouse Beach jet skis. The patients got out of the water with no apparent injuries; however, their vessel was still overturned. A towline between a fishing charter and the overturned vessel snapped in attempt to rescue. Whilst the towline was re-established, the patients were returned to shore for assessment by paramedics. The vessel was rescued shortly after.



- On the 18th of January 2019, lifeguards requested assistance from the Ambulance as a male and female in their early 70's were hit front on by a car outside Shelly Beach Surf Life Saving Club. Both patients were conscious and breathing, however, bleeding and injured. Ambulance arrived and transported one patient to the Gold Coast Hospital and the other patient to Lismore Hospital, both patients in a critical condition. The Ballina Supervisor has passed on the names of the lifeguards on duty to ALS administration to be offered counselling.
- On the 24th of January 2019, the State Operations Centre was advised of lifeguards attending to an incident where a tree had fallen on a 60 year old male in Lennox Head. The Police, Ambulance and Westpac helicopter all attended the scene with the lifeguards, retrieving the man from under the tree. He was suffering crush injuries and was transported to the Lismore Base Hospital via the Ambulance.
- On the 25th of January 2019, lifeguards responded to a knee dislocation after a 60 year old female fell from a large surging wave that hit her leg at Lighthouse Beach. The lifeguards on duty treated the injury with ice, compression and elevation with no referral for further medical assistance.
