I, the undersigned, hereby apply to the local land board for the land district of _____ for an order determining the manner in which fencing work between the adjoining properties described hereunder is to be carried out.

NOTES:

- (1) Full description of lands. Street addresses, Lot/Portion numbers, Parish, County or other particulars.
- (2) If it is impracticable to carry out fencing work on the common boundary, the line on which the proposed fencing work is to be carried out must be specified.
- (3) Set out such matters as the type of fencing work eg wooden posts, rails and palings of a particular height, length of fence eg from the alignment of the building etc, the name of proposed fencing contractor.
- (4) If it is proposed that the cost of the fencing work is to be borne otherwise than in equal proportions, the proposed proportions must be specified.
