THERE ARE SEVEN OFF-LEASH AREAS IN THE SHIRE

Council recognises the importance of dogs being allowed time to exercise unrestrained and there are seven off-leash areas in the shire. Dogs can exercise, roam freely and socialise under the supervision of their owner or person in charge at the following designated off-leash areas:



- 1. BICENTENNIAL GARDENS**
(Northern Area Of The Reserve) Ballina

- 2. COMPTON DRIVE**
East Ballina

- 3. GAP ROAD**
Alstonville

- 4. SEVEN MILE BEACH**
North of the Lennox Head – Alstonville Surf Life Saving Club

- 5. BALLINA HEIGHTS ESTATE**
Eastern Reserve Area Ballina Heights

- 6. HEADLANDS DRIVE DRAINAGE RESERVE**
Skennars Head

- 7. THE SPIT**
Ballina

CONDITIONS OF USE

- Your dog must always be under effective control. 'Effective control' means your dog responds to your command and remains close to you.
- If your dog is not sufficiently trained to be under your effective control and shows signs of anti-social behaviour and aggression you must remove the dog immediately from the area.
- Pick up your dog poo and dispose in a waste bin.
- Be considerate of all other users of the area. It is not for the exclusive use of dogs and their owners.
- Your dog must be accompanied at all times by an adult or person over 16 years.
