Byron Bay Road temporary detour 14 to 15 April – Hutley Drive North extension

The Hutley Drive extension project is progressing well and Council is now upgrading Byron Bay Road and constructing the new roundabout and associated infrastructure.

To complete these works a temporary detour of Byron Bay Road will be in place from 7am Tuesday 14 April until 4pm Wednesday 15 April 2020. During this time motorists travelling in both directions will be detoured at the North Creek Road roundabout and at Byron Street.

These works will only proceed if weather conditions remain favourable.

During the two-day detour, Council will excavate the existing road pavement along this section of Byron Bay Road to make way for the new roundabout and road surface. The length of this detour will allow these works to be completed efficiently while also ensuring the safety of motorists and on-site staff.

Ballina Shire Council commenced work in November 2019 to extend Hutley Drive North to Byron Bay Road. Once complete, the extension will provide a safer connection to major roads and improve access to the shopping centre development and sports fields within the Epiq Estate at Lennox Head.

Traffic control and variable message boards will be in place to notify motorists of traffic changes. Council thanks motorists for their patience and understanding during these works.
