What is household problem waste?

Household problem waste is potentially harmful to the environment and human health if not disposed of correctly.

This includes household chemicals such as paints, e-waste, batteries, mobile phones and lightbulbs. Many of these items can contain valuable resources like precious metal and can be recycled.

The options available for the safe and environmentally sensitive disposal of your household problem waste in Ballina Shire include:
