Re: Angels Beach Drive and Bangalow Road – Detour for Intersection Widening Works

The Angels Beach Drive and Bangalow Road Lane Improvement project is progressing well, with works currently underway to extend Sheather Street and connect it with Angels Beach Drive.

Intersection widening works will commence along Bangalow Road from Tuesday 22 February 2022.

To enable these works to be carried out as quickly as possible a section of Bangalow Road, north of the roundabout and south of Clark Street, will be closed in both directions. Please see the map overpage for further details.

From 22 February 2022 to early April 2022 (weather and site conditions permitting), the following detours will be in place:

• Heading south on Angels Beach Drive Detour via the industrial estate. Turn right at the new connection to Sheather, Hogan and Clark Streets to access Tamarind Drive, the airport and McDonalds/Ballina Fair. Access to Ballina CBD and Ballina Central Shopping Centre will continue as normal.

- Heading east (inbound) on Tamarind Drive/ Bangalow Road
 Detour via the industrial estate (Sheather, Hogan and Clark Streets) to access Angels Beach
 Drive/Lennox Head. Access to Ballina CBD via Kerr St and Fox St.
 Note there is no right hand turn at Sheather Street onto Angels Beach Drive
- Heading west (outbound) on Bangalow Road towards Tamarind Drive
 Detour via Fox and Kerr St. Access to Angels Beach Dr/ Lennox Head, Ballina Central Shopping
 Centre and Kentwell Community Centre remain unchanged.

Motorists should expect delays and plan to leave earlier than they normally would. Temporary pedestrian and cyclist detours will also be in place around work zones. To enable traffic flow within the industrial estate temporary no parking areas will be installed. Please follow the signage.
