

Lake Ainsworth - Foreshore Improvement Works Stage 2

Ballina Shire Council are due to commence Stage 2 of the Lake Ainsworth Foreshore Improvement Works. This stage of works include open space enhancements including closure of the eastern road noting emergency access will be maintained at all times. Works are scheduled to commence on **Tuesday 7 May** with the road closure to follow during the week.

Once completed, the \$1.7 million improvement project will boast additional barbeques, pathways, picnic tables, formalised parking, erosion rehabilitation and landscaping.

Council will complete the eastern precinct works in sections (starting at the northern end) to help maintain pedestrian access during construction. Council anticipates stage 2 works will be completed by August, weather permitting.

Skennars Head Sports Fields Expansion Project

Council is commencing works on the Skennars Head Sports Fields Expansion project. The investment will include a new senior playing field, new junior playing field, sport field lighting and irrigation, improved drainage, and additional parking with new site entry.

This project is possible due to \$1,285,000 in Council funding and \$990,000 in funding from the State Government Stronger Country Communities Fund.

Council is liaising directly with sporting clubs to keep disruptions to a minimum during the works. The project is expected to be completed late 2019.
