Roadworks - Epiq Estate Lennox Head

On behalf of the Epiq Shopping Centre Developer, Ballina Shire Council advises Lennox Head residents of essential roadworks surrounding the new Epiq Shopping Centre. Works began on Monday 6 April and are expected to continue for four weeks. During this time, sections of both Hutley Drive and Snapper Drive will be under traffic control, and sections of both roads may be detoured via Anchorage Avenue and Outrigger Road.

The construction works are being completed by Morgans and include the construction of right turn bays, kerb realignment, pedestrian refuge and relocation of bus bay.


