Re: Angels Beach Drive and Bangalow Road Service Relocation Works

Ballina Shire Council is pleased to announce service relocation works will commence on **Monday 30 August 2021** as part of the Angels Beach Drive and Bangalow Road Lane Improvement project. Early works will involve the relocation of street lighting, water, sewer and stormwater infrastructure at the roundabout.

These works are expected to be completed by the end of September 2021 (weather and site conditions permitting), with intersection widening works to commence early in 2022. Once complete this project will improve safety, congestion and traffic flow through the roundabout at Angels Beach Drive and Bangalow Road.

Traffic impacts – During these works traffic management will be in place reducing the intersection to one lane where required. Motorists should expect delays and plan to leave earlier than they normally would.

Pedestrian access – Temporary pedestrian and cyclist detours will be in place around work zones. Please follow the signage.

Planned outages – Power and water outages may be necessary during these works. Council and/or Essential Energy will notify affected businesses and residents in advance before any outages occur.
