Concept Design for River Street Duplication Exhibition and Information Sessions

To support a growing community and address the congestion along River Street, Ballina Shire Council is continuing plans to duplicate River Street from the Pacific Highway to Kerr Street. Once complete, the four-lane roadway will double the road's current capacity and cater for traffic up until 2036.

Ballina Shire Development Control Plan 2012 Draft Amendment to Chapter 4 Residential and Tourist Accommodation - Element T - Incorporation of Existing Dwellings into Attached Dual Occupancy Development

Council has prepared amendments to the Ballina Shire Development Control Plan 2012 (the DCP). 'Element T' incorporates controls to address amenity impacts associated with the retention of existing dwellings as part of attached dual occupancy development.

The draft amendments are proposed to apply to the R2 Low Density Residential zone at Alstonville and Wardell, taking effect only once LEP amendments, which permit attached dual occupancy development, have been finalised.

Persons making a submission may need to disclose political donations/gifts provided to a Councillor or Council employee. Significant penalties apply for non-disclosure.
