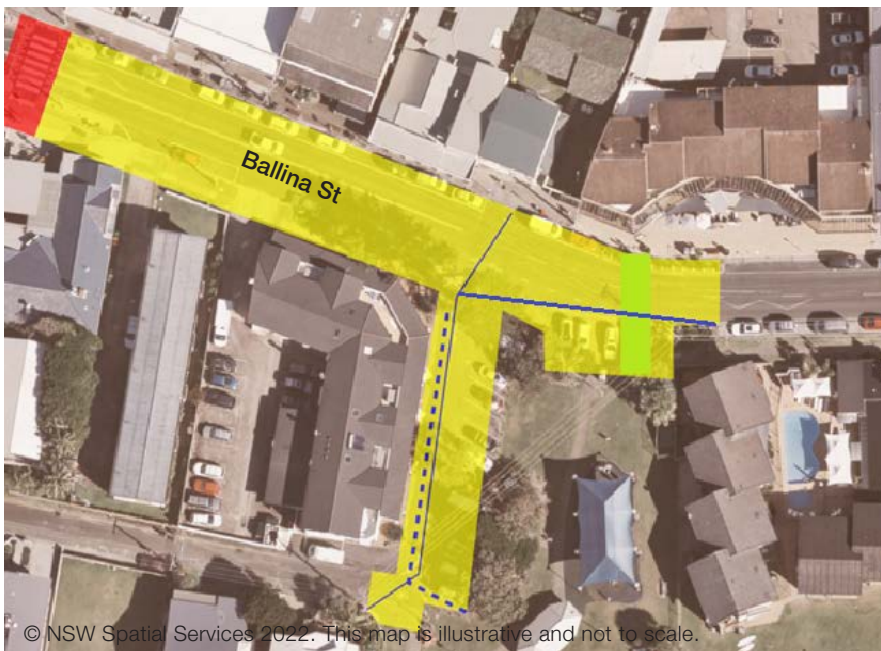







PROJECT UPDATE FOR LENNOX HEAD RETAILERS AND RESIDENTS WEEK AHEAD - 15 AUGUST TO 19 AUGUST 2022

- The northern section of Rayner Lane and entry from Ballina St will be **closed from Monday 8 August for approximately 6 weeks**, subject to weather and ground conditions.
- Every effort will be made to maintain business and resident access although, at times, access may be altered or unavailable for short periods. Council's crews will communicate directly with impacted businesses and property owners.
- Beach access via Rayner Lane will be maintained for as long as possible
- Excavation of new stormwater from Rayner Lane to end of Ross Park
- Continued excavation and back fill of Ballina Street
- Commence Rayner Lane kerb and road compaction.

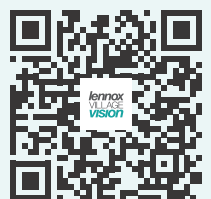


-  Construction of new pedestrian crossing
