## Update Byron Bay Road temporary detour 5 April – Hutley Drive North extension

Council will temporary detour a section of Byron Bay Road on Sunday 5 April. These works were originally planned for Sunday 29 March, but were delayed due to an uncertain weather forecast.

Ballina Shire Council commenced work in November 2019 to extend Hutley Drive North to Byron Bay Road. Once complete, the extension will provide a safer connection to major roads, reduce vehicle traffic in residential areas and improve access to the shopping centre development and sports fields within the Epig Estate at Lennox Head.

The Hutley Drive extension project is progressing well and is now at the stage of upgrading Byron Bay Road and starting to construct the new roundabout and associated infrastructure.

To help complete the next stage of these works Council must trench across Byron Bay Road to install stormwater pipes, upgrade the electrical network and remove existing kerb and gutter.

To complete these works a temporary detour of Byron Bay Road will be in place from 8am to 4pm on Sunday 5 April 2020. During this time motorists travelling in both directions will be detoured at the North Creek Road roundabout and at Byron Street.

These works will only proceed if weather conditions remain favourable.

Traffic control and variable message boards will be in place to notify motorists of traffic changes. Council thanks motorists for their patience and understanding during these works.
