Flood Recovery

The 2022 floods were an unprecedented disaster. The NSW Government remains focussed on helping the community recover and rebuild.

We are working in a considered way with all stakeholders, local support providers and councils to help those who need it and make sure people have access to support services if they wish.

You may be eligible for NSW and Australian government assistance.

The NSW Government is undertaking outreach to community members to provide information and access to services across seven Northern Rivers Local Government Areas.

Flood Property Assessment **Program**

If your property was damaged by the floods beginning in February 2022, you may be eligible for the Flood Property Assessment Program (FPAP). The program will provide you with a free, detailed assessment report, including a comprehensive scope of repair works and an estimate of repair costs.

Back Home Grants

Service NSW is accepting late Back Home Grant applications for customers in extenuating circumstances.

Disaster Relief Grant

The Disaster Relief Grant helps people recovering from a disaster restore a basic standard of living.

You may be eligible for financial support

- You're the owner of, or a tenant who lives in (or lived in at the time of the floods), a property that was damaged or destroyed
- The damaged property was your principal place of residence
- You do not have insurance for the damage
- You are a low-income earner with limited financial resources.

To apply call Service NSW on 13 77 88, Monday to Friday 7am-7pm.

Members of the Disaster Relief Grant team can also meet with you in person at one of the pop-ups across the region.

Resilient Homes Program

The Resilient Homes Program offers prioritised homeowners one of the three available measures, based on expert property assessments, flood impact severity data, safety risks and potential future flood levels:

- · Home buybacks the homeowner receives a payment for the purchase of their house and land, or
- Home raising funding is committed to elevate liveable areas above a property-specific flood level, or
- Home retrofit funding is committed to retrofit and/or repair liveable areas to improve the resilience of these areas for future floods.

Ballina Shire Recovery Support Services

If you have been affected by floods, Recovery Support Services will help you in your recovery journey by providing personalised, long-term support.

Recovery Support Services will link you to your own personalised recovery support worker, who can help you navigate and access services and disaster assistance packages.

Recovery support workers will walk alongside you, providing you with help to address the complex challenges and issues that emerge throughout your recovery journey. Recovery Support Services will also build your connections with local community resources and can link you to programs and services.

There is no cost, participation is voluntary and customer-led, and you have a choice of providers. Recovery Support Services are funded by the NSW Government.
